

It would be a huge undertaking. Would the Motor City Rockets be interested in hosting a national meet? Where would we begin? Would enough people volunteer? How would we finance it? Could we handle something so big? Several members got busy, very busy. They prepared questionnaires to elicit the interest level of the club. The questionnaires were followed by phone calls. The results were very encouraging, with the majority of the club showing interest and a willingness to work.

From there a core team was put together to gather information on what it would take to put on such a feat. We knew we would need some help, so we went to those who had experience in such matters. In that regard, the North Texas Oldsmobile Club (NTOC) and the Cadillac Club proved to be invaluable by supplying us with information such as the numbers of committees needed and the duties of said committees. In fact, some members had already stepped up to coordinate some of these committees.

Now what? Well, if you're going to host a car show, you have to have somewhere to put those people and their cars. So the next step was securing a host hotel. We started looking at area hotels. We approached the Hyatt in Dearborn because they had hosted car shows previously including the Cadillac Club 100th anniversary meet. After many meetings, their venue was selected and negotiations were underway. More planning was underway and a proposal was presented to the OCA board at the Seattle's Nationals. We found out later that our club had been selected to host the 2008 Nationals. Now it was official. Later the contract with the Hyatt was signed.

In February of 2006, we held our kick-off meeting for the 2008 Nationals at the Hyatt, the host hotel. It gave members a chance to see the Hyatt and become familiar with the surroundings. A lunch was provided and it was well attended. It was decided that from that point on, we would combine our regular MCR meetings with our Nationals meetings. At this time, our co-chairs, Bill Szelag and Alan Wilcox gave an overview of the entire event. We voted on our theme and the "Motor City Rocket Reunion" was off and running. Committees were formed and the functions of those committees were defined. An executive group was also formed to oversee all decisions. With the 2006 Nationals being held in Dallas, several members decided to attend that event, volunteered and came away with loads of information. We also presented to the OCA board an update on the progress we had made up to that point. As the rest of 2006 passed, a project plan was put in place and more members came forward to help.

Now with two meetings under our belt in 2007, we've made significant progress. All committee coordinators and associates are busy with their specific duties and reporting monthly on their progress. As this year's Nationals approach, some members are preparing to go to Bowling Green. We will again present another update on our plans to the board. In addition, over 30 of our club's members and spouses/friends will be volunteering there. The goal is to have much of the framework events and pricing done by June so when we man our MCR Reunion information table we will have a finalized registration form!! When the 2007 Nationals end, our club will be even stronger with more and deeper friendships formed having accomplished such a major project as a team. Although a lot of work is getting done we are also having much fun in the process. There'll be much more to report as we get closer to August of 2008 and don't forget, it's never too late to get in on all the fun.

So to answer the question, Can we do this? You bet we can and we are! It's just another testimonial to the talents, friendships and the work ethic of the Motor City Rockets.
